

Housing Tips for Grand View Lodge

MCMA Conference, May 3-5, 2017

*Registration for housing opens 3/3/17 and **ENDS 4/1/17!***

In order to make the reservation of your sleeping rooms at Grand View Lodge easier and to help you understand the limitations of the facility, the MCMA Planning Committee has put together these important reservation tips for you:

- For 2017, there will be three housing tiers. Their definitions are below:
 - **Private Bedroom** (Single Occupancy) – a private bedroom is a room and bathroom all to yourself (or for you and your spouse/significant other) and has *NO shared living space*. The cost for this is \$124/night.
 - **Private Bedroom/Shared Space** (Cabin Mate) – this is a *private bedroom and bathroom* that is in a cabin with other private bedrooms and bathrooms. You will share only the cabin with others and will still have your own private bedroom/bathroom – the cost for this is \$105/night.
 - **Shared Bedroom/Bathroom** (Double Occupancy) – this is a bedroom with two double-sized or queen-sized beds. This bedroom/bathroom will be shared with another individual (roommate), and may or may not be in a cabin with a shared living space – the cost for this is \$70.95/night.
- **MCMA** has over 95% of the Main Campus reserved, which is enough for at least 141 individuals. If more people select **private bedroom/shared space** or **double occupancy**, more individuals can be placed on the main campus. There are registrants who will be placed elsewhere on the property (typically across the highway). Some people like the relative quiet of being off the main campus/across the road! Free shuttle transportation is provided, 24 hours per day. If you prefer this option, please indicate this in the “comments” section of your reservation form.
- If you don’t mind being placed across the road, please write that in the “comments” portion of your reservation form.
- On the reservation form, we will ask you to indicate other people with whom you are willing to share space (cabin mates or roommates as described above).
